Immigration Fees Guide

ESTIMATED FEES

All estimates are subject to VAT at 20%. A UK Visas & Immigration ("UKVI") application fee current at the time of submission will be payable. Immigration healthcare surcharge will also be payable in relation to applications.

Naturalisation as a British Citizen and other types of British Nationality applications	£3,000 – £3,500

The above fees are estimated. If the application is more complex or time consuming than originally envisaged, we may have to revise our estimates upwards. Applications may be more complex or time consuming for the following reasons:-

1. If you have an adverse immigration history and have had a UK visa or other visa refused.
2. If you have overstayed an existing visa in the UK.
3. The nature of the evidence you have provided for the application and the amount of evidence we need to consider.
4. If we advise you that you need to obtain further evidence for the application.

FIRST INTERVIEWS

We do not offer free initial interviews. We will usually propose an initial consultation with you to assess your status and ability to meet the requirements of the Immigration Rules for the application you wish to make. The consultation fee will cover up to 2 hours of our time. This initial consultation fee is separate to the fees quoted above for the substantive applications

OTHER COSTS AND EXPENSES

There may be other expenses which are not included in the above such as translator's fees, if we need to get a document translated into English. We will always obtain a quotation from the translation company and ask for your approval before proceeding. Translation fees vary enormously depending on the language and the amount of documentation that requires translating.

If you wish to request the Home Office to process your application on an expedited basis (if the application is eligible) higher UKVI application fees will apply.

We will charge for courier fees, if applicable to send documents to you or the Home Office.

WHAT SERVICES ARE INCLUDED

The work will involve:

- At first meeting, discussing your circumstances in detail and confirming whether this is the most appropriate application for you to make.
- If you do not meet the criteria, what advice we provide to you.
- Considering the evidence you supply and if necessary assisting you to obtain further evidence which may include witness evidence.
- Preparing your application and any dependent application and submitting it with a detailed covering letter to the Home Office.
- Giving you advice about the outcome of the application.

WHAT SERVICES ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE ABOVE ESTIMATES FOR SUBSTANTIVE APPLICATIONS

- If the Home Office refuse your application, advice and assistance on any Appeal or Judicial Review of the decision.
- Any further work after submission of the application.

HOW LONG WILL THE APPLICATION TAKE?

We cannot advise with absolute certainty how long the Home Office will take to process your applications. We will need to check current processing times before we submit the application for the method of submission you choose.

We will do our best to submit your application as soon as reasonably practicable after we have obtained your full instructions and subject to you providing all the necessary supporting evidence for the application.
